## The Project



DisCo represents a logical follow-on from earlier Euratom projects (such as SFS, NF-PRO, MICADO, REDUPP and FIRST-Nuclides) which focused on dissolution and radionuclide release from conventional UO<sub>2</sub> spent fuels.

In particular, this project aims to fill the knowledge gap on spent fuel dissolution arising from the development and use of novel types of fuel (Cr/Al-doped and MOX).

The project started on 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2017 and will last for 4 years. It is implemented by a consortium with 16 Beneficiaries from 8 countries and the European Joint Research Center (EC). National Waste Management Organizations and Regulatory Authorities contribute to the running project by participation in the End-User Group, by co-funding Beneficiaries, and provide for knowledge and information transfer.
